OUR VISION:

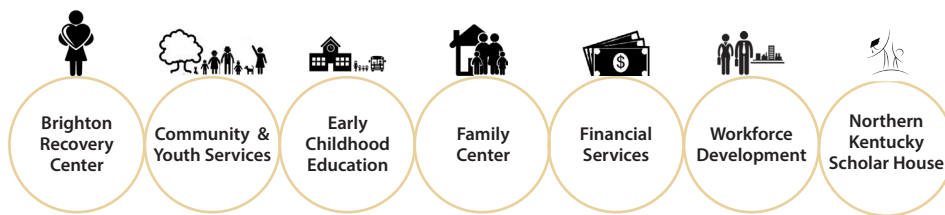
To be an innovative leader that strengthens the vitality of the community and engages people as they work and live to achieve their hopes and dreams.

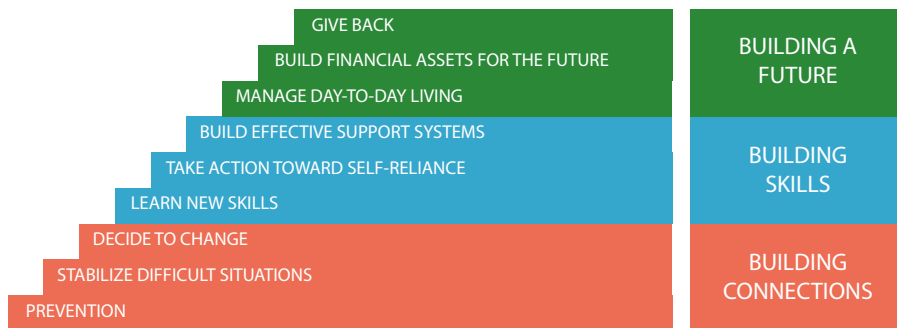
WHAT WE DO AND WHY

51,735

individuals (or 25,137 families) received help during a crisis, had a basic need met, or received a connection to other services in the community.



6,795

children in our early childhood education programs, and **88%** enrolled a minimum of six months demonstrated growth in multiple domain areas.



3,357

homeless and runaway youth received crisis services at Homeward Bound Shelter.



6,436

families served with free tax preparation resulting in **\$9,437,804** in tax refunds.



63,145

individuals received workforce services such as job fairs, job readiness, training or placement. **80%** of those placed retained employment at six months.



2,011

women were served residentially through Brighton Recovery Center for Women. **79%** reported no relapse six months after completion.

Our Homeward Bound Shelter and Independent Living Program are CARF accredited demonstrating that we are guided by internationally recognized service standards and best practices.

Brighton Center is 1 of 4 regional Financial Opportunity Centers recognized by the Local Initiatives Support Corporation (LISC) and United Way of Greater Cincinnati for effecting positive systemic change.

Brighton Center meets the Better Business Bureau's standards for charitable accountability including governance, finance, fundraising and information, and measuring effectiveness.

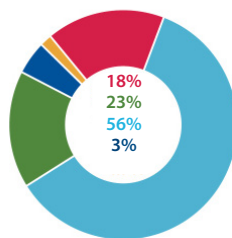

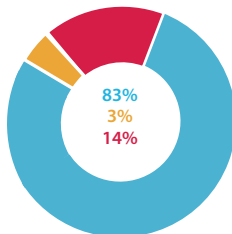
- 1 EDUCATION:** Supporting educational advancement and engagement at all levels (early childhood to post-secondary education).
