Students Rock the Vote!



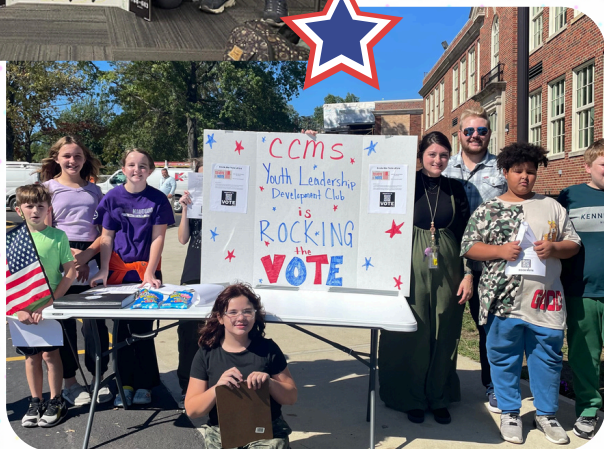
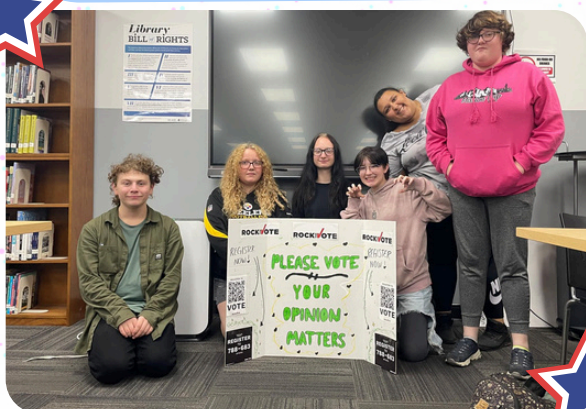
